1. Human Rights Day is observed on 10th December.
2. International Mountain Day was celebrated on 11th December. This Year Theme is "Mountain under Pressure: climate, hunger, migration".
3. Two-day ASEAN-India Connectivity Summit (AICS) on the theme "Powering Digital and Physical Linkages for Asia in the 21st Century" began in New Delhi.
4. UN Women in collaboration with Facebook inaugurated a two-day event in Mumbai titled 'We The Women' to empower and recognize the magnificent contribution of women in our society.
5. Goa chief minister Manohar Parrikar launched country's first-ever mobile food testing laboratory which will enable on-the-spot food safety tests to be conducted in Goa.
6. The Centre has sanctioned Rs.75 crore for setting up a Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) bottling plant in Meghalaya.
