1. World Diabetes Day is observed on 14th November. This year theme is "The Family and Diabetes".
2. Children's Day is celebrated on 14th November across India.
3. ISRO's heavy-lift rocket GSLV-Mark-Three has proven its reliability by successfully launching the communication satellite GSAT-29 from the second launch pad of the Satish Dhawan Space Centre at Sriharikota in Andhra Pradesh.
4. Prime Minister Narendra Modi addressed world's largest financial technology festival Fintech in Singapore.
5. Culture Minister Dr Mahesh Sharma inaugurated the 38th India International Trade Fair (IITF) at Pragati Maidan in New Delhi.
6. The Uttar Pradesh government has approved the renaming of names of Allahabad and Faizabad divisions to Prayagraj and Ayodhya divisions respectively.
7. Union Ministers DV Sadananda Gowda and Narendra Singh Tomar were assigned additional portfolios of the Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers and the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, respectively.
