- At Dr B R Ambedkar Bhavan Rural Development and Panchayat Raj department was organized.

- 2019 has been declared as Jalavarsha.
- After Rajasthan Karnataka is the 2nd largest drought-prone state in the country.

- IHC was initially held at Maharashtra.
- Due to financial reasons, it was canceled.

- In India to promote housing finance institutions, NHB has been set up.
- NHB stands at ₹2,000 crore.
- ₹1,450 crore has been subscribed by RBI.
- At present, the capital is fully subscribed by RBI.

IIT scientist discovered tadpole-like jets on Sun

- Abhishek Srivastava has discovered tadpole-shaped jets.
- On the sun it is coming out of regions with intense magnetic fields.
- Formally called pseudo-shocks.
- The "tadpoles" are made entirely of plasma.
- It is estimated 99% of the observable universe.
- It could help understand why corona.
- Over 200 times hotter than its surface.
