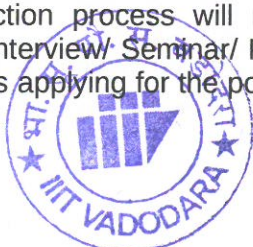
(1.8). It is mandatory for all candidates to fill up GOOGLE APPLICATION FORM available on the Institute’s website.

(1.9). List of the Candidates, “whose applications are received by the due date” will be published on the Institute website without screening within 15 days for the information of all concerned.

(1.10). Candidates applying for two or more posts are required to fill up & forward separate application forms for each post along with the supporting documents and necessary fee (as applicable). Single Application form received for two or more posts will be summarily rejected without any communication by the Institute.

(1.11). The selection process will normally consist of scrutiny of Application forms received followed by the Interview/ Seminar/ Presentation. 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(1.12). 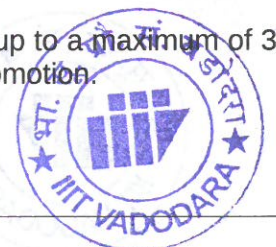
