The mission aims at creating efficient and effective institutional platforms of the rural poor enabling them to increase household income through sustainable livelihoods and improved access to financial and public services. A multidisciplinary professional team, has been constituted in NRLPS. This team consists of senior professionals, experienced consultants and young professionals among others.
