1. Interested candidates should apply with CV (containing qualifications, achievements, age, email ID and contact number details), passport photograph and photocopies of relevant documents. 2. Last date for submission of application is **2nd October, 2022**.
3. Age limit as on 2nd October, 2022 is 28 years for general candidates, relaxable up to 5 years for SC/ST and 3 years for OBC candidates as per GoI Rules.
4. Candidates will be required to produce all the testimonials relates to education and community certificate (if applicable) in original with an additional set of self-attested photocopies and two recent passport size photograph during the interview.
5. Selection will be done on the basis of interview and academic background. The interview date for shortlisted candidates will be informed through email/telephone.
6. The tenure will be co-terminus with the project. The selected JRF will be encouraged to register for Ph.D. depending on the eligibility, however, in such case the total duration of the PhD fellowship will not exceed five years from the date of appointment of JRF.
