**NOTIFICATION**

Applications are invited from eligible Indian citizens who are Natives/Residents of Union Territory of Puducherry for the Direct Recruitment to be held for the post of Sub-Inspector of Police (Group 'B' Non Gazetted, Non-Ministerial) in the Police Department, Puducherry as detailed below:

Abbreviations: **UR**-Un-Reserved, **EWS**- Economically Weaker Section, **OBC**- Other Backward Classes, **SC**- Scheduled Castes, **ST**- Scheduled Tribes.

**Note:-**

- (i) The vacancies notified are existing as well as anticipated. However, Government reserves the right either to enhance or to reduce the number of vacancies notified depending upon the actual requirement at the time of selection and also to cancel the recruitment process. No interim enquiry will be entertained.
- (ii) 33 % of Horizontal Reservation is applicable for women as per G.O.Ms.NO.76 dated 14.12.2016 of Home Department, Puducherry.



**1. QUALIFICATION FOR ELIGIBILITY:**

Graduate from a recognized University or its equivalent.

**2. AGE LIMIT**

Between 20 and 27 years as on 09.12.2022. Age limit is relaxable in respect of OBC/SC/ST, Ex-Servicemen and In-service applicant as detailed below:

<b>In-service applicant</b> (Refer XII )	5 years (for posts which are in the same line or allied cadres and where a relationship can be established that the services rendered by them in the Department will be useful for efficient discharge of duties in the post for which selection is made).

*\*\* Requirement of Age for candidates belonging to various categories are given in Part-II of this Notification.*

**3. NATIVITY/ RESIDENCE:**

Those who are the native of the Union Territory of Puducherry or who have continuous residence in the Union Territory of Puducherry for the last 5 years immediately preceding the date of notification only are eligible to apply for the post. The applicant can apply without a certificate but ON SELECTION should furnish the fresh Nativity/Residence Certificate issued by the Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, Puducherry not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar at the time of Certificate Verification.

**4. COMMUNITY CERTIFICATE:**

The candidates can apply without a certificate but must claim proper category. ON SELECTION they should submit a fresh Community Certificate obtained in the prescribed form issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, Puducherry not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar at the time of Certificate Verification. Candidates selected under SC quota should furnish Community Certificate issued under "**The Constitution (Puducherry) Scheduled Castes Order, 1964**" and "**The Constitution (Puducherry) Scheduled Castes Order, 2002**" in respect of "**Puthirai Vannan**". Applicants applying under ST Quota should furnish Community Certificate issued under "**The Constitution (Puducherry) Scheduled Tribes Order, 2016**". **OBC** candidates shall produce Non Creamy Layer Certificate. Any false information provided by the candidate / applicant may lead to actions including criminal case.

Candidates belonging to the communities of OBC (Puducherry UT), MBC, EBC, BCM and BT categories of Puducherry UT will be considered under the one umbrella of OBC, for the purpose of reservation. Hence, the posts earmarked for OBC in this notification applies commonly to all the above communities viz., OBC (Puducherry UT), MBC, EBC, BCM and BT categories of Puducherry UT.

**5. CERTIFICATE FOR EWS CANDIDATES:**

The candidates selected under EWS category should submit income & asset certificate obtained in the prescribed form issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar at the time of certificate verification.



**6. MODE OF RECRUITMENT / PATTERN OF EXAMINATION:**

The vacancies will be filled up through the different stages of selection process as detailed below:-

**(i) Physical Standard Test – Stage-I**

**Note:**

- (1) All the above events are compulsory and qualifying events for the next event.
- (2) Ex-servicemen and Commissioned officers including ECOs/SSCOs are not required to qualify the physical efficiency test. They will be eligible to appear for the written test if they qualify in the Physical Standard Test.
- (3) Three chances will be given to qualify in the long jump and high jump.
- (4) Physical Standard Test & Physical Efficiency Test, written test, Certificate verification and medical examination will be held in Puducherry only.

**APPEAL** : The appeal made by any candidate on the same day of the Physical Standard Test / Physical Efficiency Test will be examined and decided by the Committee constituted for this purpose.

**iii) Written Test : (200 Marks)- Stage-III**

Candidates who qualify the Physical Standards and Physical Efficiency tests shall undergo Written Test. The questions will be in objective type upto Graduate level. The question papers will be in two parts each of two hours duration:

The Question paper will be in bi-lingual (except for General English) i.e., in English and in any one of the regional languages namely, Tamil or Telugu or Malayalam. Therefore, the candidates should indicate their choice of the language in which they prefer to write the examination, in the on-line application. Negative mark of 0.25 will be awarded for every wrong answer and multiple answers will be treated as a wrong answer. Candidates are, therefore, advised to keep this aspect in mind while answering the questions.

Answering would be in the form of shading the correct answer by using **BLACK BALL POINT PEN** only and the applicants are permitted to take the carbon copy of their answer sheet along with their question booklet.

The answer key will be published in the recruitment website <https://recruitment.py.gov.in> and also in the official website of Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms <https://dpar.py.gov.in> after completion of written examination process.

Minimum qualifying marks prescribed for the written examination:

A list of candidates will be provisionally shortlisted from the merit list based on the marks obtained by the applicants in the Written Examination subject to reservation as per rules in force. Minimum qualifying marks to be secured in each paper i.e.,(Part-I & Part-II) by the various category of candidates are as follows:-

UR	:	35%
OBC / EWS	:	30%
SC / ST / XSM	:	25%

**Note:**

*The validity of operation of wait list, if drawn, will be two years from the date of declaration of the result / publication of select list. The wait list will be operated in the event of occurrence of a vacancy caused in the Select list due to rejection of candidature for non-production of required certificates, non-appearance of candidate for certificate verification, non-joining of candidate within the stipulated time allowed for joining the post or when a candidate joins but resigns or dies within a period of one year from the date of joining etc.*

**7. MEDICAL EXAMINATION:**

The candidates selected in the Written Test shall be subjected for medical examination to assess their medical fitness as per the medical standards prescribed through the Standing Order issued by the Government as detailed below:-

**Medical standards:**

(a). Eye sight:

**Distant Vision**

Normal-Both eyes should be 6/6

OR

(1) Better eye with correction 6/6

(2)Worse eye vision 6/ 12(without correction)

OR

Both eyes should be 6/9

**Near Vision**

Normal- Both eyes should be J<sub>I</sub>

OR

Better eye with correction J<sub>I</sub> and worse eye without correction J<sub>II</sub>.

II. Free from colour blindness

(b) Hearing:

Free from any disability

(c) Defects or deformity:

Free from any defect or deformity of limbs.

(d) Disease:

Free from hernia, piles, respiratory disease, diabetes or any other disease, which will adversely affect the work of SI of Police.

(e) Others:

Should not be flat-footed or suffering from knocked-knees and bowed legs and should not be overweight as prescribed in the Medical Standards followed by Life Insurance Corporation of India.

**Note:**

1. Physical Standard Test & Physical Efficiency Test, written test, Certificate verification and medical examination will be held in Puducherry only. No travelling allowance will be paid for attending the Tests except for the SC/ST candidates of outlying Regions.

**8. TRAINING:**

The Selected candidates will be placed under probation for a period of TWO YEARS from the date of joining the post as per Recruitment Rules (including the Basic Training for one year).

**9. DATE AND VENUE OF PST, PET & WRITTEN TEST:**

The PST, PET & Written Test will be held in Puducherry only. The exact date, time and venue of the said tests will be intimated in due course in the recruitment website & also in leading newspapers.

**10. HOW TO APPLY AND LAST DATE FOR APPLICATION:**

Applicants fulfilling the eligibility criteria as mentioned above may apply online only through the official website <https://recruitment.py.gov.in> from **10.11.2022 (10.00a.m)** to **09.12.2022 (05.45p.m)**.

**11. PROCEDURE FOR IN-SERVICE APPLICANTS:**

Only the candidates working as Asst. Sub-Inspector of Police/Head Constable/Police Constable under the cadre control of Police Department, Puducherry of the Union Territory of Puducherry will be considered for the post of Sub-Inspector of Police and allowed to appear as In-service candidate by availing the permissible age relaxation mentioned in the statement under "Part-II-Age Limit" of this notification.

The above applicants applying as in service applicant with age concession should forward a copy of the online generated application through their respective controlling officers within the due date ie on or before 05.45 PM on 09.12.2022 and send it to **"The Officer on Special Duty, Police Department, Puducherry-605 001"**.

The application of In-service candidates which are not received within the due date of 05.45 P.M. on 09.12.2022 will be summarily rejected. Advance copy of the application for in-service candidate will not be entertained.

**12.** Further instructions will be given to the candidates in the admit card of the respective tests.

**GENERAL INSTRUCTION TO THE CANDIDATES****PART - I**

**Applicants should read the following instructions carefully before applying:-**

1. Mode of applying for Direct Recruitment to the post of Sub-Inspector of Police is **only through online**.





2. Don't register multiple online applications. Only a single application should be registered. All multiple online applications will be rejected summarily and the candidates will lose their chance to appear for the exam.

### 3. **Photograph & Signature uploading:**

Applicants shall upload their Photograph and Signature using either option 1 (or) option 2 provided in the recruitment portal as given below:-

#### Option 1 (Scanned Photograph and Signature as a single image)

Applicants are instructed to scan their recent passport size colour photograph & signature in an A4 sheet with 200 DPI resolution, dimensions should be minimum of 600 x 600 pixel and the file size should be less than 150KB. (as shown in guidelines video for uploading and cropping your photograph and signature during online application)

#### Option 2 (Scanned Photograph and Signature as separate images)

Applicants are instructed to scan their Photograph in JPEG format with 238 x 306 pixel dimension and the file size should be less than 50KB.

Signature file format should be JPEG, dimensions should be 350 x 150 pixel and file size should be less than 30KB

4. The applicants have to register their Mobile Number in the online portal "<https://recruitment.py.gov.in>" for applying through online. Then they will be receiving Username and Password through SMS in the mobile number provided while registration. Thereafter, the applicants have to login into the online portal using the Username and Password for applying to the post of Sub-Inspector of Police.
5. The applicants are also advised to **change the default password** received in their mobile at first login. It is the applicant's responsibility to take ownership of the password and it should not be disclosed to anyone. Any deviation will be at the risk of the applicant.
6. The applicants will be allowed to view, print & check the status of their application and download the Admit card by login into the online portal using the username and password. Hence, they are advised to keep the **user name and password safe** for future reference until the recruitment process is over.
7. The applicant, after applying can also make corrections in their on-line application, if any error occurs while entering the data. They are allowed to avail this facility till last date for receipt of application.



8. The information/data furnished by the applicants in the online application are final and cannot be altered later so the candidates are advised to be cautious while furnishing data / information while applying online.
9. Applicants are advised to keep a copy of the application generated online for their reference.
10. Applicants need not send the printout of the online application or any other supporting documents to this Department.
11. Original Certificates are required to be produced by the provisionally short-listed candidates after the notification of results of this recruitment at the time of certificate verification.
12. All communications with regard to this recruitment will be published in the Website "<https://recruitment.py.gov.in>". Applicants are advised to access the above website and watch news and dailies regularly for information. They are advised to keep the mobile number given in the online application active for sending SMS connected with this recruitment.
13. After scrutiny, the status of the application will be indicated in the website <https://recruitment.py.gov.in>". The applicants are advised to check the above official website to know their application status.
14. In view of the likely huge number of applicants, scrutiny of the eligibility criteria etc., will not be undertaken at the time of PST/PET & Written test. Therefore, the application will be accepted provisionally only. The candidates are advised to go through the requirement of nationality / residence, community, educational qualification, age, physical standards etc., and satisfy themselves that they are eligible, before applying. Candidature will be cancelled if any information or claim is not found to be true when the scrutiny of documents is undertaken by the Departmental Recruitment Committee after the Examination. Departmental Recruitment Committee's decision shall be the final in this regard.
15. Candidates seeking reservation benefits available for SC/ST/OBC/EWS must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation as per eligibility prescribed in the Notification. They should also be in possession of the certificates in the prescribed format in support of their claim.
16. No correspondence will be entertained with regard to the recruitment process. Candidates are advised to verify the status of their application / Admit Card through online only.
17. A separate press note will be issued in leading regional news dailies regarding the issue of Admit Card to participate in the PST/PET through online. The eligible applicants can download their Admit Card from the website <https://recruitment.py.gov.in> by using the "User Name and Password".




18. The admission to the PST, PET and Written Test is only provisional. Success in the Test confers no right to appointment. The appointment is subject to verification of character and antecedents, educational qualification/residence/community and any other special category claimed by the individual including medical fitness.
19. Change of address and mobile number, if any, after submission of application should invariably be intimated to the Department by registered post with acknowledgement due. Otherwise the Department will not be responsible for any delay/non-delivery of letters/SMS messages.
20. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the PST/PET and Written Test except SC/ST candidates who will be paid TA as per rules.
