Applications are invited for the post of JRF (01 post) with emoluments of Rs. 31,000/- pm + 16% HRA in a ICMR sponsored Project entitled "Mechanistic elucidation of the differential roles associated with Hsp70 isoforms in tumour subtypes with the aim to identify safer inhibitors for tumour sensitization" sanctioned for three years. The post is temporary and coterminus with the project. The candidates for this position should hold Master's degree in Life Sciences/Biochemistry/ Biotechnology/Molecular & Human Genetics/Zoology or allied area, with at least 55% marks from recognized University. The candidate should have qualified NET/GATE. The upper Age Limit is 35 years, relaxable for 5 years for SC/ST/Physically Handicapped/Female candidates.
