As prescribed by the UGC for Assistant Professor in the concerned/allied subject.


Honorarium: Rs. 1,500/- per lecture subject to a maximum of Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty thousand) only per month.

Essential qualifications as prescribed by the UGC for the post of Assistant Professor:

A:

- i) **A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned /relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.**
- ii) **Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their subsequent amendments from time to time, as the case may be, may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:**

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- a) **The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;**
- b) **The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;**
- c) **An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;**
- d) **The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;**
- e) **The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any other similar agency.**

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned. Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) of the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018 for Universities shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview.
