Eligibility Criteria

1. Essential

(a) PhD in Civil Engineering (With Specialization in Transportation Engineering/Transportation Planning/Traffic Engineering/ Infrastructure Engineering or related specialization). Candidates who are in the final year of their PhD program may attend the interview; however, if selected, they must have submitted their dissertation for evaluation prior to joining the position.

2. Desirable

Experience of carrying out all stages of road safety audits independently as per IRC SP88. Knowledge of geometric design for various categories of roads. Certificate of successful completion of the 15 days Road Safety Audit Program approved by Indian Road Congress and Ministry of Road Transportation and Highways.

3. Key responsibilities for Project Office

- To independently lead the Onsite Road Safety Audit teams on various State Highways and National Highway stretches.
- To draft the onsite observations and suggest appropriate recommendations as per IRC codes.
- The project officer will also be in charge of the Driving Simulator lab at IIT Jammu and be involved in related research

4. General Instructions

- The engagement shall be purely on **contract basis for six months**, extendable based on the performance review.
- The Project Officer shall not be permitted to take up any other assignment during the period of engagement with IIT Jammu.
