- 9. Monitoring the performance of the live websites.
- 10. Knowledge of code versioning tools including Git, Mercurial, and SVN.
- 11. Strong understanding of responsive web design techniques.
- 12. Create charts, graphs, infographics, illustrations, and touch up artwork, using Adobe software, Canva and other software's/platforms.
- 13. Able to understand independently to gather the website designing requirements and give design deliverables.
- 14. Manage deadlines and communicate.
- 15. Strong attention to detail in terms of quality of the deliverables.

The Website Associate will also update the content on each and every section of different websites of the Mission or any other related activities as desired by the team.

Qualifications:
