**VACANCY NOTICE**

**RECRUITMENT TO GROUP 'B' NON-GAZETTED, NON-MINISTERIAL POST OF "SENIOR INVESTIGATOR/ ASSISTANT STATISTICAL OFFICER" UNDER THE DIRECTORATE OF ECONOMICS & STATISTICS, ANDAMAN & NICOBAR ADMINISTRATION BY CONDUCTING OPEN, COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION.**

1. This Vacancy Notice is in continuation to our earlier Vacancy Notice published in **"The Daily Telegrams" dated 30.9.2020** wherein online applications were invited from the eligible candidates for recruitment of **Eighteen (18)** posts of Senior Investigator/Assistant Statistical Officer from **1.10.2020 to 30.10.2020**.

Now vacancies have been enhanced from Eighteen (18) to Thirty Nine (39) posts, as such, **ONLINE APPLICATIONS** are further invited from the eligible candidates for recruitment to the **Group 'B', Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial** post of **"SENIOR INVESTIGATOR/ASSISTANT STATISTICAL OFFICER"** in **Level-6(Rs.35400-112400)** of the Pay Matrix in the Amalgamated Statistical Cadre under the Andaman & Nicobar Administration as per the details given below.

**N.B.**

- (i) Candidates who have already applied in terms of previous vacancy notice dated 30.9.2020 (uploaded in the website on 1.10.2020) need not to submit applications again. The list of candidates who have applied against the above vacancy notice and have been shortlisted as eligible to appear for the Computer Based Test (CBT) is attached. The candidates have been shortlisted based on preliminary scrutiny only and the selection of candidates shall be subject to the result of the Computer Based Test and final verification of documents related to the essential educational qualification, age limit and category etc.
- (ii) Number of vacancies shown under column-3 above are subject to variation.

- (iii) Reservation for OBC applicable to those OBCs as specified in the Administration's circular No. 8-3/2003-TW dated 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2006.
- (iv) Reservation for disabled persons (Persons with disability) & EWS shall be applicable as per the guidelines/instruction issued by the Govt. of India / A & N Administration from time to time.

**3. Eligibility Conditions:**

- (i) All candidates shall be required to apply Online for the post whether they are registered with the Employment Exchange or otherwise.
- (ii) The Departmental Candidates/Govt. Servants must also apply online.
- (A) The following documents issued by the Head of the Department / Competent Authority are to be uploaded by the Departmental Candidates/ Govt. Servants at the time of filling up of online application form:
  - (a) 'No objection Certificate' is mandatory for all the Departmental Candidates/ Govt. Servants.
  - (b) Candidates seeking age relaxation as a Departmental Candidate/Govt. Servant should also upload 'Service Certificate' indicating the length of continuous service which should be for not less than three years in the immediate period preceding the closing date of receipt of online application.
- (iii) Applicant must be an Indian Citizen.

**4. Age Limit:** Not exceeding 30 years.

Note: - A Candidate for this examination must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age over and above 30 years as on the closing date of receipt of online application. Further, 02 years of age relaxation has been granted over and above the upper age limit prescribed in the relevant RRs, as a one-time measure, for direct recruitment of all Group-B (NG) posts vide A&N Administration's Order No.2758 dated 20.10.2022.

Besides the above, age relaxation in respect of reserved categories of aspirants permissible beyond the upper age limit are as detailed below:

**5. Educational & Other Qualifications:**

- a) Educational Qualification: (As on 30.06.2023)

**Essential:** Must possess Master's degree in Statistics/ Operation Research/ Mathematical Statistics / Applied Statistics or in Economics/ Mathematics/ Commerce (with Statistics as one of the subjects) from a recognized University or equivalent.

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**Desirable:** 2 (Two) years experience in collection, compilation, interpretation and analysis of Statistical Data.

b) Process of Certification and Format of Certificates:

Candidates who wish to be considered against the vacancies reserved or seek age-relaxation **must produce their original certificates issued by the competent authority and to submit a copy of the original certificate duly Self-Attested whenever sought by this Directorate**, otherwise, their claims for OBC/ EWS/ PwD status will not be entertained and their candidature/applications shall be considered under **General (UR)** category. Certificate for the status of Creamy Layer issued between **01.07.2020 to 30.06.2023** only will be accepted.

**NOTE:** Candidates are cautioned that they shall be permanently debarred from appearing for the examination conducted by the Directorate of Economics & Statistics, A & N Administration in case, they fraudulently claim OBC/ EWS/ PwD status.

c) Candidates with less than 40% disability will not be considered under the OH/III category as the case may be.

6. Fee Payable:

(b) No fee for PwD/Women candidates of any community. No "fee exemption" is available to Gen/OBC/EWS male candidates and they are required to pay the full prescribed fee.

(c) After completing payment, candidate has to upload the transaction slip in the portal with size 10 to 500 KB in .jpg/.jpeg format.

7. Centre of Examination:

The Computer Based Test (CBT) will be held (in **online mode**) at **Port Blair** only.

**Computer Based Test (CBT)**

Subject of the Computer Based Test (CBT), time allowed, and maximum marks for each subject will be as follows: -

**NOTE-I:** There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer. No marking or no negative marking will be awarded to unanswered questions. Candidates are therefore, advised to keep this in mind while answering the questions.

**Date and Timings of Examination:**

The CBT (Computer Based Test) examination shall be conducted in multiple shifts on the date & time as indicated in the Admit Card/Hall Ticket.

Each candidate is required to appear for examination on the date & time mentioned in the Admit Card/ Hall Ticket.

The Computer Based Test (CBT) will consist of three subjects, having "Objective Multiple- Choice- type Questions". The minimum qualifying marks will be 40% in each subject. The questions for all the three subjects will be set in English language only.

**Indicative Syllabus for Computer Based Test (CBT):**

(i) **General Awareness/General Intelligence:**

Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidates, general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test the knowledge of current affairs, observation/experience and elementary knowledge of computers. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to History, Culture, Geography, Economic, Science, General Politic and Scientific research.

(ii) **General English and Comprehension:**

Questions in this test will set to assess the knowledge of English Language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms etc. There will also be questions on comprehension of a passage.

(iii) **Statistics (Post Graduation Level):**

- (a) **Sampling Theory:** Population and Sample, Parameter and Statistics (Census method and sampling method of data collection), Objects of sampling, methods of sampling, Random and non-random, techniques of sampling under each method, sampling error and non-sampling error, sampling distribution of a statistic, law of statistical regularity, law of inertia of large numbers, central limit theorem.
- (b) **Theory of Estimation:** Meaning concept of an estimation, concept of estimator, types of estimation, point and interval estimation, desirable properties of an estimator, standard error of estimator, confidence limits for a population parameter.
- (c) **Theoretical Distribution:** Definition, Types of theoretical distribution, discrete theoretical distribution, binomial distribution, Poisson distribution, continuous theoretical distribution, normal distribution, standard normal variate-Z distribution, other theoretical distribution, students "t" distribution, Chi-Square Distribution, F-Distribution.
- (d) **Correlation and Regression Analysis:** Concept of correlation, types of correlation, bivariate distribution and co-variance, simple correlation, Karl Pearson's product moment coefficient of correlation measure, partial correlation, multiple correlation, Spearman's rank correlation coefficient, properties and uses of correlation, Meaning of regression, types of regression, simple and multiple linear and non-linear regressions, concept and method of least squares, line of best fit, regression coefficients, line of regression of x on y, line of regression on y on x, properties of regression coefficients, utility regression analysis in economic studies, coefficient of determination.
- (e) **Analysis of time series:** Definition and components of a time series, mathematical models, additive model and multiplicative model of a time series, seasonal variations, measuring

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through—simple average method-ratio to trend method, cyclical variations, measuring through residual method, trend and its measurement through—method of moving averages and method of least squares, fitting a second degree trend, growth curves, logistic curve add gompertz curve, interpolation and extrapolation.

- (f) Index Numbers: Definition of index number, types of index number, price index, quantity index, value index, simple index number, weighted index number, construction of index number, problems in construction, methods in construction, simple and weighted-Laspeyre's price index (CPI in India-Paasche's Price Index, Fisher's ideal index, Splicing of index number-deflating (finding real wages).
- (g) Measures of Central Tendency and partition values: Meaning of average-types of average, arithmetic mean, median, mode (for raw data and ungrouped frequency distribution and grouped frequency distribution), geometric mean, harmonic mean, quartiles, deciles, percentiles (for individual series, discrete frequency distribution and frequency distribution with class interval).
- (h) Measures of Dispersion: Meaning & types of dispersion, range, quartile deviation, mean deviation, standard deviation and variance (along with absolute measure, the relative measure or co-efficient of each type of dispersion), co-efficient of variation, combined standard deviation, Lorenz curve(application in income distribution).

#### **8.Verification of documents:**

All the successful candidates short listed after CBT examination should get their original certificates/ testimonials duly verified as are mandatory and submit another self-attested copy of all those mandatory certificates /testimonials in person along with the printed copy of Online Application to the authorized officers/officials at the prescribed venue on the schedule date & time, failing which, his/her candidature shall be struck off from the relevant panel for all purposes and no further request/correspondence shall be entertained.

#### **9. General Instructions to be complied with by the candidates in the Computer Based Test (CBT):**

- (i) Candidates must select the answers in the Computer Based Test (CBT) on their own.
- (ii) Candidates are not permitted to use calculators and other electronic gadgets except as specified in the Notice. They should not, therefore, bring the same inside the Examination Premises/ Venue.
- (iii) If any candidate is found to possess mobile phones or any other means of wireless communication in the working (Switch on) or switched off mode, his/her candidature shall be cancelled forthwith.

#### **10. Mode of Selection:**

- The minimum qualifying marks will be 40% in each subject.
- Candidates qualifying the Computer Based Test (CBT) shall be appointed on the basis of merit list subject to fulfilment of all essential requirement stipulated in existing RRs.

Provided that OBC, EWS and PwD candidates, who are selected on their own merit without relaxed standards, will not be adjusted against the reserved share of the vacancies. **Such OBC, EWS and PwD candidates will be accommodated against the general/unreserved vacancies as per their position in the overall Merit List.**

The reserved vacancies will be filled up separately from amongst the eligible OBC& EWS candidates which will thus comprise of OBC and EWS candidates who are lower in merit than the last general candidate (UR) in merit list of unreserved category but otherwise found suitable for appointment even by relaxed standard.

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Physically Handicapped (OH/HH) category candidate who qualifies on the basis of relaxed standards viz. age limit, experience or qualifications, permitted number of chances in CBT examination, extended zone of consideration, etc. is to be counted against reserved vacancies and not against general vacancies subject to fitness of such candidate for selection. Such candidates may also be recommended at relaxed standards to the extent of the number of vacancies reserved for them, to make up for the deficiency in the reserved quota, irrespective of their rank in the order of merit.

Success at the examination confers no right of appointment whatsoever unless the Directorate of Economics & Statistics, A&N Administration is satisfied after such enquiry/scrutiny or verification of certificates/documents as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects of appointment to the service/post and the decision in this regard shall be final & binding.

**11. RESOLUTION OF THE TIE CASES:**

In cases where more than one candidates secure the equal aggregate marks, tie will be resolved by applying the following methods one after another: -

- (1) Date of birth i.e. the candidate older in age gets preference.
- (2) By referring to the alphabetical order of the names taking first name into consideration.

**12. ADMISSION TO THE EXAMINATION:**

All candidates who apply in response to this advertisement on or before the CLOSING DATE & TIME FOR ONLINE APPLICATION will be assigned Roll numbers. The Admit Cards/ Hall Tickets will be made available on the website of A & N Administration i.e. <https://erecruitment.andaman.gov.in> around 3 weeks before the Computer Based Test (CBT). In case, a candidate does not find his/her name in the above uploaded list, candidate must immediately contact the Statistical Officer (HQ), Directorate of Economics & Statistics at [sohq.des.ani@gmail.com](mailto:sohq.des.ani@gmail.com) with proof of having submitted his/her application online. Failure to do so shall deprive him/her of any claim for consideration subsequently.

The candidates must carry at least one photo bearing identity proof such as Driving License, Aadhaar Card, Voter Card, College/University ID Card, Income Tax PAN **in original and Admit Card downloaded from the website**, while attending the examination, failing which, they shall not be allowed to appear for the examination.

**13. Action against candidates found guilty of misconduct:**

While filling the application form, the candidates are cautioned that they should not furnish any particular that is false or suppress any material information. Candidates are also cautioned that they should in no case, attempt to alter or otherwise tamper with any entry in a document or the attested certified copy submitted by them, nor should they submit a tampered/fabricated document.

Without prejudice to criminal action/ debarment from appearing the examination conducted by the Dte. of Economics & Statistics wherever necessary, candidature will be summarily cancelled at any stage for a period of maximum 3 years of the recruitment in respect of candidates found having indulged in any of the following malpractices:

- 1) In possession of MOBILE PHONE & ACCESSORIES AND OTHER ELECTRONIC GADGETS WITHIN THE PREMISES OF THE EXAMINATION CENTRES, WHETHER IN USE OR IN SWITCHED OFF MODE AND IN PERSON OR OTHERWISE.
- 2) Involved in various malpractices.
- 3) Using unfair means in the examination hall like copying, cheating etc.
- 4) Obtaining support for his / her candidature by any means.
- 5) Impersonate/ procuring impersonation by any person.

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- 6) Submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with.
- 7) Making statements which are incorrect or false or suppressing material information.
- 8) Resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for the examination.
- 9) Misbehaving in any other manner in the examination hall with the Supervisor, Invigilator or Administration's representatives.
- 10) Intimidating or causing bodily harm to the staff employed by the Administration for the conduct of examination.
- 11) To be ineligible for the Examination by not fulfilling the eligibility conditions mentioned in the Notice.
- 12) Candidature can also be cancelled at any stage of the recruitment on any other ground which, the Directorate of Economics & Statistics, A&N Administration considers to be sufficient cause for cancellation of candidature.

**14. Directorate of Economics & Statistics decision shall be final and binding:**

The decision of Directorate of Economics & Statistics in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of examination(s) and allotment of posts/organization to selected candidates shall be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry/correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.

**15. Court's Jurisdiction:**

Any dispute in regard to this recruitment shall be subject to Courts/tribunals having jurisdiction over the A & N Islands only.

16. The results of the Computer Based Test (CBT) will be made available on the Administration's Recruitment Portal <https://erecruitment.andaman.gov.in>.

**17. Important Instructions for the Candidates:**

1. This Directorate has advertised notice for recruitment to the Group 'B' Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial post of "Senior Investigator/ Assistant Statistical Officer" for which Master's degree in Statistics/ Operational Research/ Mathematical Statistics / Applied Statistics or in Economics/ Mathematics/ Commerce (with Statistics as one of the subjects) from a recognized University or equivalent is the minimum qualification.
2. Directorate of Economics & Statistics will undertake scrutiny of applications for the eligibility and other aspects before the Computer Based Test (CBT). The candidates are advised to go through the requirements of educational qualification, age etc. and satisfy themselves that they are eligible before applying.
3. **Candidates are advised to go through the detailed instructions contained in this notice which are available on the websites of A&N Administration i.e. <https://erecruitment.andaman.gov.in> before applying. The candidates are advised to check the details and satisfy themselves that all information is correctly filled. No changes to the information filled by the candidates will be allowed at any subsequent stage of the Online Application process once the same is submitted.**
4. Candidates seeking reservation benefits available for OBC/ EWS/ PwD etc. must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation as per eligibility prescribed by the Govt./A & N Administration from time to time.   - (iv) The candidates should upload specimen signature (signed in blue ink) having size of **10 to 20 KB** in jpg/jpeg format.
