

- 20 Reservation in Direct recruitment shall be applicable as per Govt. of India Norms. Govt. of India O.M. No. 36039/1/2019-Estt(Res) dated 31st January, 2019.
- 21 SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PwBD/EWS certificates should have been issued by the competent authority designated by Central / respective State/ UT Government and should be valid as on the closing date for submission of application. Divyang / PwBD certificate should mention percentage of disability.
- 22 The recruitment process will be governed by the Rules of Recruitment for Faculty (Direct Recruitment) approved by the Board of Management of the Institute in its 32nd meeting and subsequent amendment, if any during the process of present recruitment.

Short Listing Criteria:

23. The prescribed Essential Qualification/Experience indicated are bare minimum and mere possession of same will not entitle the candidates to be called for test/interview.
24. The Short-Listing Criterion for the Post of Assistant Professor in Engineering & Technology, Humanities/Sciences will be as per **APPENDIX-V**.



- 5 marks will be awarded for each R&D project if the candidate has completed R&D Project amounting more than 10 lac as co-principal investigator (Co-PI).
- 2.5 marks will be awarded for each R&D project if the candidate has completed R&D Project amounting less than or equal to 10 lac as co-principal investigator (Co-PI).
- 10 marks will be awarded for each approved patent if the candidate got approved /published the patent as a principal investigator (PI).
- 5 marks will be awarded for each approved patent if the candidate got approved /published the patent as a co-principal investigator (Co-PI).
