**Required 'Assistant Professor' (Two Posts) on Contract Basis for School of Development Studies (SDS) at TISS-Mumbai Campus.**

The Tata Institute of Social Sciences ([www.tiss.edu](http://www.tiss.edu)), established in the year 1936 is a Deemed to be University, fully funded by the University Grants Commission, Govt of India. TISS is a Grade I University with NAAC score of 3.89/4 and is ranked 60 under NIRF University Rank Category for 2022.

With four campuses at Mumbai (main campus), Hyderabad, Guwahati and Tuljapur (rural campus), TISS currently offers 05 Undergraduate programmes, 54 Masters' Degree programmes and 20 Ph.D. programmes in a range of socially relevant inter-disciplinary areas of applied Social Sciences including 34 Bachelor of Vocational degree programmes.

Freedom and autonomy shape the positive work ethos and culture of the Institute and facilitate strong linkages between teaching, research, field action and policy engagement. The Institute encourages and supports researchers to engage in foundational, applied, field and action-oriented research, and it also nurtures research collaborations nationally and internationally, with a commitment to creating a just society through education, generation of knowledge and field action initiatives.

**Brief About School: School of Development Studies, Mumbai Campus:-**

**The School of Development Studies (SDS)** was created in 2012 with the aim of achieving excellence in the pursuit and advancement of knowledge in development. Education and research in the School focuses on development debates and practices, and their implications for the excluded and marginalized communities. The School aims to organise and conduct research on development issues and its core thematic areas from a multi-disciplinary critical perspective. Two Master's programmes are offered under the School: Development Studies and Women's Studies.

The SDS contributes significantly to the body of development research and analysis and in training a large number of students and scholars to work on various issues of development. The SDS offers M.A., M.Phil. and Ph.D. Programmes in Development Studies and Women's Studies and MA in International Electoral Management and Practices (MIEMP).

**The School invites applications for TWO posts of 'Assistant Professor' to be filled on a contract basis, initially for a period of one year and may be extended based on performance of the candidate and requirement of the Institute. These positions are for the Advanced Centre for Women's Studies (ACWS) and the Centre for Study of Developing Societies (CSDS).**

**Remuneration:-** Consolidated Salary @ Rs. 86,088/- p.m. (Pay Band Rs. 15600 - 39100; AGP Rs. 6000/- as per 6<sup>th</sup> CPC).

## **Educational Qualification:**

### **Essential Qualification:**

A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in **Women's Studies/Sociology/Anthropology/Development studies or allied field of Social Sciences** from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

### **Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, Eligibility (A or B):**

**A.** The candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET / SLET / SET for recruitment and appointment of 'Assistant Professor' subject to the or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a referred journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR / CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

**Note:** NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

### **OR**

**B.** The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following:

- i. Quacquarelli Symonds(QS)
- ii. the Times Higher Education (THE) or
- iii. the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

### **Desirable Qualifications:**

#### **(a) Advanced Centre for Women's Studies (ACWS):-**

1. Candidates with prior research and/ or teaching experience in the following areas are preferred: Gender and Development, Gender and labour, Feminist methodology.
2. Candidates with a good publication record will be preferred.

3. Candidates selected for positions will contribute to teaching, student mentoring and research projects in the School of Development Studies and in the Centres they are affiliated.

### **(b) Centre for Study of Developing Societies (CSDS):-**

1. Basic and Advanced Qualitative Research Methods, Social Institutions and Stratification in India, Anthropology and Development, Sociology of Development, and Political Sociology.

2. Candidates with prior research and/ or teaching experience will be preferred.

3. Candidates selected for positions will contribute to teaching, student mentoring and research projects in the School of Development Studies and in the Centres they are affiliated.

### **Application Fee:**

The application fee of Rs. 1000/- be paid online. The application fee for SC/ST/PWD candidates will be Rs. 250/- if they attach the required certificate to the online application form. The women applicants are waived from payment of application fees. The application will be valid only on receipt of the application fee, if applicable. Fees once paid, shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

### **Other Conditions:**

- The Institute reserves the right to relax the qualifications of the candidate based on the work experience and to relax age in the case of persons already holding comparable positions in a University/Research Institution of repute.
- The Institute reserves the right to invite persons for interviews who may not have applied as per the above procedure and not fill up the vacancy advertised.
- Since applications received may be short-listed, merely possessing the prescribed qualifications and the requisite experience would not entitle a person to be called for the interview.
- The post is unreserved, but candidates belonging to the reserved category can apply.
- No queries or correspondence regarding the issue of call letter for interview/selection of candidates for the post will be entertained at any stage and canvassing in any form is strictly prohibited and will lead to the candidate being debarred from consideration for the post.
- The candidate under employment must produce a 'No Objection Certificate' from their employer to appear for an interview.
- No TA/DA is payable for appearing for the interview.
